



Administrator of the Year award given to Nancy Charles

Nancy Charles, Administrator of Northland Home Health, was presented with the Administrator of the Year award at the Marquette County Human Service Board meeting last week by Tracy Dudzinski, President of the Board of Directors of Cooperative Care, whose headquarters is in Wautoma.
